<b>Preamble</b>		<p>The government of Alberta's Remembrance Day Act requires all school boards to hold Remembrance Day ceremonies in all of its schools.</p> <p>This regulation outlines the legal requirements for Remembrance Day ceremonies at all Calgary Board of Education schools.</p>
<b>Remembrance Day ceremonies</b>	<b>1(1)</b>	<p>In compliance with the Remembrance Day Act, principals must ensure that on Remembrance Day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) a remembrance ceremony is held from 11:00 a.m. to at least 11:05 a.m., or</li><li>(b) two minutes' silence is observed from 11:00 a.m. to 11:02 a.m.</li></ul> <p>(2) If the remembrance ceremony is held at the school, all students must either attend the ceremony or remain in the school, silent, during the ceremony.</p> <p>(3) If Remembrance Day falls on a day on which the school is not open, the remembrance ceremony must be held on the school day immediately preceding Remembrance Day.</p>
<b>Other appropriate activities</b>	<b>2</b>	<p>Schools are encouraged to commemorate Remembrance Day with other appropriate activities in addition to those required by the Remembrance Day Act.</p>
