



CALGARY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Administrative Regulation 8001 - Off-Street Parking Facilities

Off-street parking facilities in conformity with the regulations of the City of Calgary will be provided at all schools. Where recommended by the Chief Superintendent, a limited number of car plugs will be provided, such car plugs to be made available to the school staff at a rental sufficient to cover the cost of the service.

1. Where a parking area is provided on the school grounds, plug-in facilities for car heaters are provided on request, on the following basis:

Minimum installation: Two plug-ins.

Maximum installation: Not to exceed 80% of the full-time staff members, including caretakers and secretaries.

2. Plug-in facilities will be available to individual staff members on application according to the following priority:
 - a. Principal and assistant principal
 - b. Full-time staff members, including caretakers and secretaries
 - c. Part-time and relieving teachers.
3. Applications will be taken each fall, according to instructions issued by the accounting office. Rental fees, to be set from time to time, are payable with the application.
4. If a number of applications received from any school is less than the number of plug-ins installed, the number of plug-ins applied for will be assigned, and the electricity supply cut off those not applied for.
