- All other PATs must be administered in a window (identified in green on the schedule).

 - June window: June 14 25

Provincial Achievement testing in the 2020-21 school year will include the following:

English Language Arts Part A and Part B for Grades 6 & 9

- K&E English Language Arts Part A and Part B for Grade 9
- French Language Arts Part A and Part B for Grades 6 & 9
- Mathematics Part A and Part B for Grades 6 & 9
- K&E Mathematics for Grade 9

All schools in The Calgary Board of Education will follow this schedule.

In January 2020, a group of leaders were consulted to provide feedback regarding the Provincial Achievement Test Schedule dates.

Considerations from Previous Years

- Schedule to allow as much teaching time as possible
- Double the allotted time (impact on bus pick up)
- Variability in which tests come first, mid and last
- Availability of manipulatives (math)
- Availability of technology
- Availability of staff for supervision and accommodations
- Time for marking and return
- Engagement of students to the end of calendar

Considerations Voiced During the Creation of This Schedule

- For January PATs, the group considered the placement of Mathematics most carefully as this is the most commonly administered PAT in the January sitting in the CBE.
- The group noticed an increase in the number of students who are utilizing the extended time that is now offered. This places a burden on the school for supervision and the preference is to avoid scheduling multiple exams on a single day to avoid this issue.
- For June PATs, the strongest voiced consideration was to avoid the burden on resources (staff, technology and manipulatives) when grade 6 and 9 PATs occur on the same day.
- Those with experience teaching and administering math exams felt that beginning with PART A is a
 good warm-up to PART B and the separation of the weekend benefits students being able to review the
 concepts they found difficult in PART A before PART B.
- Bussing is a consideration for Friday PATs. It was felt that adding a PAT to the final Friday (June 25) was more favorable than having both a grade 6 and 9 exam on another day. Further when doubling time, the PAT will end by 11:30 a.m. which will not impact bussing.
- The group favored beginning with Mathematics PART A and having Mathematics Part B follow after the weekend providing time for additional review.
- The group expressed a preference to have the first Monday of PATs to prepare and test technology, rather than begin a heavy exam schedule on a Monday (FLA 6 is still placed on the Monday but represents a smaller number of writers to prepare for).
- It was noted by one member in the group that Social Studies which has historically been at the end of a PAT schedule had resulted in lower than expected performance and requested consideration for the exam that was scheduled at the end of the window. The group felt that either Science 9 or Social Studies 9 would fall on the final Friday and chose Science 9 as Social has often been at the end.
