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# Acknowledging the land where we gather









Outcomes are priority areas of focus in relation to the goal.

They reflect the desired state the CBE wants to achieve through its actions.



#### Actions

Articulated for each outcome, actions progress over three years.

They reflect the evolving environment in which the CBE operates.



### The CBE Education Plan

- A roadmap for how we can help every student achieve success. Its primary goal is to improve student learning.
  - guides the work of all schools and service units.
  - Identifies and reports on provincial and local measures to show how we are performing each year as outlined in:
    - the Alberta Education Assurance Framework,
    - the Education Act,
    - and the Fiscal Planning and Transparency Act.
- A demonstration of accountability and assurance and outcomes and measures are reported through the Annual Education Results Report (AERR).
- The Board of Trustees sets priorities and expectations through policy and monitors and assesses student and system results.


