National Sport School students moving temporarily due to water damage at facility

National Sport School students at Canada Olympic Park are being accommodated in temporary quarters due to a water line break and resultant damage in their leased building at the park.

The students will be moved to Bowness High School early next week, once arrangements to accommodate them have been made.

The students are elite athletes who combine sports training with their education. The Calgary Board of Education knows that it is important for the school community to remain together. It is therefore pleased that Bowness High School is able to accommodate all of the students in one place.

This is a temporary move and students will return to the National Sports School facility once repairs have been completed. At this point, it is too early to determine how long that will take.
