

2021 Summer School Survey Results

From March 30 to April 6, 2021, we asked the parents/guardians of current Grade 10 to 12 CBE students to complete a survey if they had a child interested in taking a summer school course. Thank you to CBE families for responding to the survey.

We received responses regarding 3,909 students. The majority of these students are planning to take one course over the summer. In particular, the most common plan is to take one core Grade 10 or 11 course.

Several other Alberta school jurisdictions conducted a similar survey. The data collected was shared with Alberta Education through the College of Alberta School Superintendents (CASS).

The survey was optional and about current intentions only. The responses do not determine whether a child will attend summer school; however, they helped the CBE to understand the level of demand for high school courses this summer. Thank you for your responses.

Question 1: What is the student's current grade level?

Question 2: How many core classes is the student planning to take? For example, Math or English are core classes worth 5 credits.
