Note | When a school has the necessary expertise and/or facilities, they offer both CTS courses and K&E occupational courses as per student requests. Many Career and Technology Studies (CTS) and Knowledge and Employability (K&E) occupational pathways require specialized facilities.

CBE high schools work closely together to support students in accessing pathways that may not be available in their home high school.

- BIT: Business, Administration, Finance & Information Technology
- HRH: Health, Recreation & Human Services
- MDC: Media, Design & Communication Arts
- NAT: Natural Resources
- TMT: Trades, Manufacturing & Transportation

Multi Cluster Courses

- Schools may offer courses that draw credits from multiple CTS occupational areas
- Course offerings, credit structure and program focus varies by school
- Check individual school websites for more information
- Examples include: Engineering Studies, Robotics, Architectural Studies

The level of the pathway offered is indicated by:

- i/a means the school offers the occupational pathway at the introductory to the advanced level
- C means the school offers courses in the occupational pathway up to and including the Credentialed level
- AP means Advanced Placement offered in specified CTS programs
