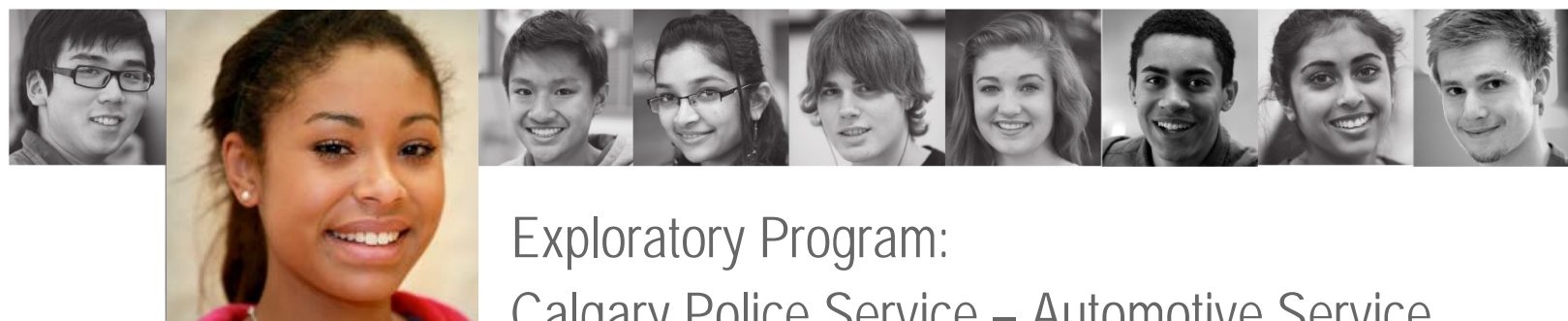

### what?

- A paid work experience program with the Calgary Police Service (CPS) Fleet department assisting with regular maintenance of Police vehicles (tires, oil changes, etc.)
- Earn high school credits in off-campus education while getting paid - \$15/hr

### who?

Open to 2 CBE high school students:

- Minimum of 16 years of age, **must have** a current class 5 operators license (no more than 6 demerit points)
- Punctual and reliable

### when?

- Monday to Thursday 1:00 – 4:00pm for one semester.
- Program dates: February to June 2018.

### where?

- Calgary Police Service Headquarters (5111 47 St. N.E.)

### why?

- To gain valuable hands-on experience and insight in Automotives while also earning work experience credits and earning a pay check (Wage - \$15/hr)
- Explore the careers related to automotive work

### prerequisites

- Students must have completed HCS 3000 and Automotives 10 and 20
- Students must provide their own CSA approved footwear and transportation to and from CPS Headquarters
