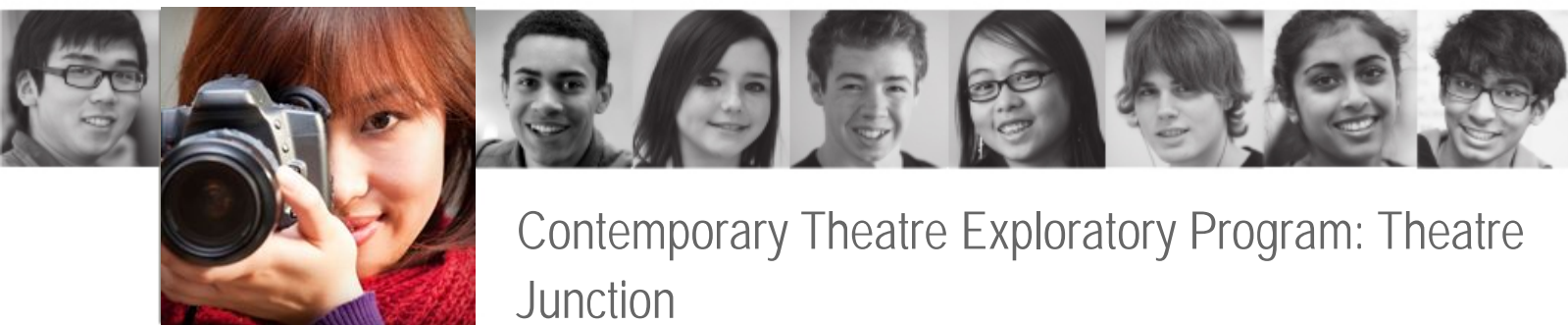

- Showcase work in front of an audience at the end of the program
- Work within the oldest theatre in Calgary, known locally and around the world for cutting-edge contemporary performing arts
