

Food Services Zoo Youth Program



Program Description

The program is designed to support students with no previous work experience to gain the skills and experience necessary to transition into the workplace. Students have the opportunity to work with a dedicated supervisor to develop their employability skills. Extensive training is provided including WHMIS and Food Safe Certification and students develop employability, customer service and kitchen operation skills. Students will work in the Concessions department at the Calgary Zoo. This is a paid work experience opportunity.

Student Eligibility

- Punctual, reliable strong communication and interpersonal skills
- No previous work experience
- Able to commit to working weekends, holidays and long weekends
- Reliable transportation to and from the work location (transit is acceptable)
- Excited to work at the Calgary Zoo an organization who's purpose is to conserve wildlife and wild places

- **Mandatory Orientation and Training** | March 14, 20 and 28, 2020. (training will be 5-6 hours each day)
- **Program Dates** | You must be able to commit to a minimum of 250 hours of work between March 14, 2020 and September 7, 2020
