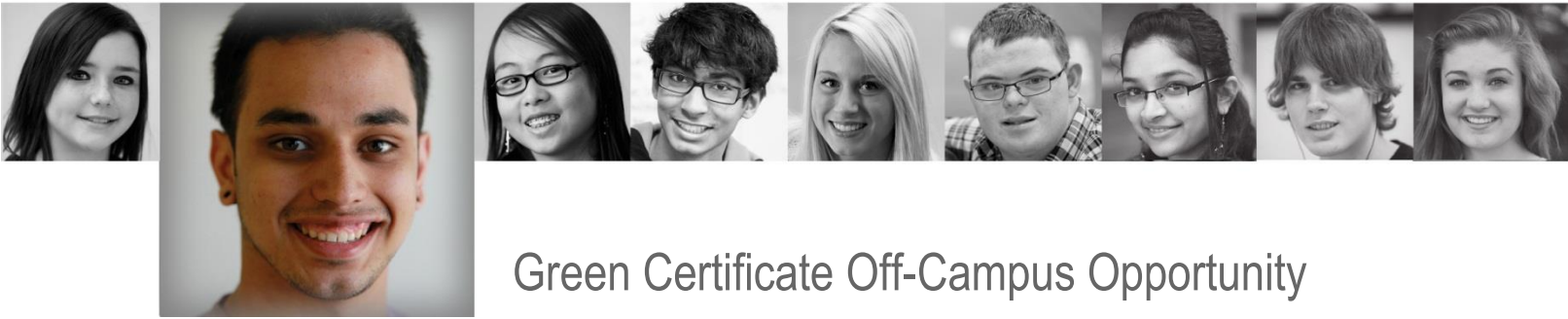

- Participate in is an apprenticeship-style training program designed by Alberta Agriculture, Food and Rural Development in one of nine specialization areas:
 - Bee Keeper Production
 - Cow–Calf Beef Production
 - Dairy Production
 - Equine Technician
 - Feedlot Beef Production
 - Field Crop Production
 - Irrigated Field Crop Production
 - Sheep Production
 - Swine Production
 - Greenhouse Production
- Gain knowledge, skills and experience in an agriculture setting
- Earn up to 16 grade 12 level credits in Off-campus Education

- Open to high school students:
 - In grade 10, 11 or 12
 - With an interest in one of the nine specialization areas
