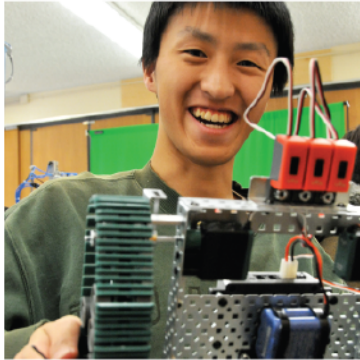


## Junior Achievement Company Program



### Program Description

### Student Eligibility

Credits are available to all CBE high school students:

- Who are in grades 10, 11 or 12 registered for Company Program
- Who have completed the pre-requisite Work Experience course HCS 3000 (available at your home school, must be completed before hours can be recorded)
- Who are able to commit to the duration of the program, 5 months, and attend an orientation on October 15, 16 or 17 (details available when you register for the program)
- Who are committed to completing time sheets and reflections on a regular basis

### Important Dates

Once you are registered you will be asked to attend one of the 3 orientation evenings held at SAIT October 15, 16 or 17. Details on how to sign up for high school credit will be provided. If you are interested in gaining credit you must connect with the CBE teacher at the orientation.
