

New schools opening in September

Buffalo Rubbing Stone School will not be ready to open on Sept. 6 due to construction delays.

- BRSS students will be temporarily located at either Alex Munro School or Panorama Hills School depending on their grade.
- We expect the school to be open on Sept. 26.
- Parents were aware of the potential for a delay in June. We are keeping them updated as details of the opening become available.

Peter Lougheed School opening may be delayed by a few days due to rain.

- We expect to open the school on Sept. 9.
- We have informed parents and will keep them updated.
- Students will receive the number of instructional hours they are entitled to even if their first day of school is later.
- We have asked parents to make child care arrangements for Sept. 6, 7 and 8 and we are connecting with our partners in the Saddle Ridge area to see if activities can be arranged for students.
