### School Calendar:

Traditional Calgary Board of Education Calendar with the exception of June 28, 2017, which will be the last day for students. Cranston School also has this as their last day.

Our year calendar aligns totally with Cranston School we have nothing different.

### Registrations:

If your child currently attends Cranston or R.T. Alderman School their registration will automatically be rolled over to Dr. George Stanley. You will not need to do anything.

If your child attends another C.B.E. school i.e. Nichol School you will need to complete a transfer form and submit it to our school through R.T. Alderman fax 403-777-7529 or drop it off at either R.T. Alderman School or Cranston School.

If you coming from another school outside of the C.B.E. please complete a registration form and again fax it to R.T. Alderman 403-777-7529 or drop it off at either Cranston or R.T. Alderman School.

NO C.B.E. students will be accepted into Dr. George Stanley School in January. The only new registrations to be accepted are those who are new to the Cranston Community.

### School Council:

A set up meeting is scheduled for September 21, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the library at R.T. Alderman School.

### Volunteer Clearances:

If you completed a clearance at a C.B.E. School it is good for 5 years. We can automatically have the information transferred over when you are ready to volunteer. These forms can be found on line. If you are a new parent to the C.B.E. please go onto the system website and complete the appropriate form and submit it to the school.

### Fees:

To date we do not have any information on fees. We do know there is a different amount charged for students in grades 4,5, and 6 as compared to students in grades 7,8,and 9. These fees are set at the system level and schools have very little to do with them.



There will continue to be fees for bussing as well as noon supervision in the case of grades 4,5, and 6.

We will be at R.T. Alderman School for the months of September, October, November and December this is a guarantee. Therefore you will be able to pay lunchroom and transportation fees for only those months.

**Lunchroom:**

The fee for lunchroom has not been established and is only for students in grade 4,5, and 6. Again, if your child will only be accessing the lunchroom for the months of September, October, November and December you may pay for only those months. In January it will be expected that students not continuing with this service will be going home for lunch. All students staying for lunch in grade 4,5, and 6 will be required to have a registration form.

**Transportation:**

This service is available for all students coming to R.T. Alderman. Once again there is a fee for the service for the months of September, October, November, and December. You may pay accordingly. After December the only students eligible for bussing are those who reside outside the walking boundary. This information can be found on the C.B.E. website or you can look at the maps in the hallway tonight or call our school administrative assistant Ms. Ardelan at 403-777-7520.

**\*\*Please complete the transportation forms on line, you do not have to pay at this time. This will allow transportation services to plan bus routes a.s.a.p. and get that information out to parents before September.**

**Communication:**

This year staff and teachers will be communicating through **SchoolMessenger**. This new system will allow us to communicate quickly and more efficiently. The system works with the information that you provided to us, so if your email or phone numbers have changed you must update your information with the office. This new system is significant for daily attendance.

**Forms:**

This year all forms will be accessible on the C.B.E. website or for specific forms for Dr. George Stanley you will find them on our website by August 21, 2016 and from there you may fill them in and then submit them to the school office. We will **not** be sending paper copies home unless requested.
