School modernization is on schedule and progressing well at Lord Beaverbrook High School. As we near completion of phase three of the modernization, we are pleased to provide this update. Preparations are being made to transition students into our new facilities for the start of semester two as follows:

1. **Culinary/Commercial Foods Lab**
2. **Cosmetology lab**
3. **Auto Body shop**
4. **Building Construction and Woodworking shops**
5. **Computer lab** (across from the Dance Studio)

The last phase of construction has started, focusing on the Automotive facility, new Heavy Machinery facility, and new Pre-Engineering lab. Inside the school, students can anticipate safety barriers built around the construction areas. These barriers will be found mostly in hallways. Students are asked to be considerate of the workspace, and be considerate for each other as they move between classrooms and around the school.
