New School Opening in Cranston

Re: Information on school designation, grade configuration changes and more

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) is pleased to be opening a middle school in Cranston in January 2017. The opening of a middle school in Cranston will impact the current grade configurations at Cranston School. The CBE aims to offer a kindergarten to Grade 9 learning continuum that minimizes transitions between schools. The new middle school in Cranston in conjunction with Cranston School will make it possible to serve all kindergarten-Grade 9 students in the community. We would like to thank all the families who took time to attend or respond to the expression of interest. This information was an important part of determining the designation for students next year.

Grade configurations at schools that serve Cranston:

| School Name | School Year | Grades |
|---------------------------|--------------------|-------------------|
| Cranston | 2016-2017 & Beyond | K-Grade 3 |
| Middle School in Cranston | 2016-2017 | Grade 4 – Grade 8 |

**The CBE aims to offer a kindergarten-Grade 9 learning continuum that minimizes transitions between schools. The new school will not offer Grade 9 in its first year.*

If the new school opens in January, where will students go in the fall?

From September through December, students will temporarily attend RT Alderman School.

To make the transition to the new schools as easy as possible, we plan to place students from Cranston in classes together with the teacher(s) who will move with them. Once at the new school, the most significant change for students will be their new surroundings as classmates, teachers and learning will remain the same.

How do I register my child?

Eligible students who are currently attending their designated schools Cranston or RT Alderman will automatically be transferred to the new middle school when it opens.

Currently we are not accepting transfers or registrations for students who are attending other CBE schools or schools operated by other districts. Information on registration for those students will be available May 2. We expect to have enough space for all eligible students living in the community.

Can my child stay at RT Alderman School?

Grade eight students may choose to stay at RT Alderman School for the entire 2016-17 school year.

- Please contact the school to inform them that you do not want your child automatically transferred to Cranston middle school.

Transportation from Cranston to RT Alderman School will be available for the entire 2016-17 school year. Transportation fees will apply.

Students may transfer to Cranston middle school or remain at RT Alderman for Grade 9 in 2017-18. Please note that school bus transportation from Cranston will **not** be available to RT Alderman for the 2017-18 school year and beyond.

Who is the new school Principal?

Patty Numan is the principal of Cranston middle school. Patty will start in her new role on April 4, 2016 and will work with parents and students to develop a school opening plan. To learn more about Patty please visit <http://www.cbe.ab.ca/newschool> and click on the Cranston middle school link.

Can my child take the school bus?

Students are eligible for transportation to their designated school if they live beyond the walk zone. Please visit <http://www.cbe.ab.ca/newschool> and click on the link to Cranston middle school to see the walk zone map. General information regarding transportation services and fees is available on our website at <http://www.cbe.ab.ca/schools/busing-and-transportation/Pages/default.aspx> and through your school. All students accessing transportation are required to pay transportation fees.

Transportation to RT Alderman School will be available until the end of June 2017.

What happens if the new school isn't ready to open in January?

CBE is closely monitoring construction progress on all schools. If there is a delay a contingency plan will be communicated to parents. Our contingency plans will ensure the learning needs of students are met. We will keep parents and the community informed of any changes to the expected opening date.



This is an exciting time. We look forward to working with you as we welcome students to their new school.
