Notice Regarding School Designation for Grade 5 to 9 Students Residing in Saddle Ridge

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

This letter is to inform parents and students that Peter Lougheed School is over capacity and is projected to be over capacity for the 2021-22 school year and beyond. This school will not be able to accommodate all students who live in Saddle Ridge beginning in 2021-22. Consequently, the Calgary Board of Education is planning to cap enrolment at Peter Lougheed School and designate overflow schools.

Effective for the 2021-22 school year, the following changes will be implemented.

- Cap enrolment at Peter Lougheed School.
 - Grade 5 and 6 students from Saddle Ridge who cannot be accommodated at Peter Lougheed School will be designated to Pineridge School in Pineridge.
 - Grade 7-9 students who cannot be accommodated at Peter Lougheed School will be designated to Clarence Samson School in Pineridge.
 - A lottery will be held for Grade 5 students. Students who are unsuccessful in the lottery process will be designated to Pineridge School.

Where will my child attend school next year?

Current Grade 5-8 students attending Peter Lougheed School will remain at the school.

Saddle Ridge students currently in Grade 4 entering Grade 5 in 2021-22 will be a part of the CBE lottery process. If unsuccessful in the lottery process, students will be attending their designated overflow school.

How do I register for school next year?

Current Grade 4 students attending Hugh A. Bennett School and Saddle Ridge School will automatically be included in the lottery for Grade 5 at Peter Lougheed School.

New students in Grades 5-9 will need to submit their registrations to Peter Lougheed School. To be included in the lottery, registrations must be received by noon on Feb. 10, 2021. Registrations received after the lottery date will be added to the appropriate priority level on the call back list in the order received.

If unsuccessful in the lottery, students will automatically be registered at their designated overflow school – Pineridge School (for Grade 5 and 6 students) and Clarence Samson School (for Grade 7- 9 students).

How does a call back work?

If space becomes available in Peter Lougheed School throughout the school year that space will be offered to students on the call back list who are currently attending the overflow location. The call back list is prioritized based on the draw order established through the lottery process.

How will students get to school?

Students are eligible for transportation to their designated school if they live beyond the walk zone. This includes students attending the designated overflow school. Families are required to register for transportation services by the deadline each year. Please note, transportation fees apply.
