## Revised Notice: Change to School Designation for K-6 Regular Program Students Residing in Redstone

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to *remind* parents and students who reside in the community of Redstone that due to continued enrolment growth at Rundle School, the school has reached capacity and will not be able to accommodate all students who live in Redstone for the 2021-22 school year and beyond.

In a notice dated June 18, 2020, the CBE informed parents that Kindergarten to Grades 6 regular program students from Redstone will be designated to Keeler School effective August 2021. At that time, CBE informed that Grade 5 students from Redstone community may remain at Rundle School to complete Grade 6 or move to Keeler School for Grade 6 in the 2021-22 school year.

This letter is to inform you that based on feedback from families at Rundle School, the CBE has decided that Grade 5 students will remain at Rundle School to complete Grade 6 in the 2021-22 school year. This means that all Grades 6 regular program students from Redstone will continue to be designated to Rundle School for the 2021-22 school year before they transition to Dr. Higgins School for Grade 7 in the 2022-23 school year.

### How will changes be phased in?

- Grade 5 students from Redstone community attending Rundle School will remain at Rundle School to complete Grade 6 in the 2021-22 school year. Siblings of Redstone students in grade 5 may choose to remain at Rundle for the 2021-22 school year. They would transfer to Keeler School for the 2022-23 school year.
- At the end of June 2021, all other students in Kindergarten to Grade 4 from Redstone community attending Rundle School will transfer to Keeler School for the 2021-22 school year.
- Grade 5 students from Redstone community attending Keeler School will transfer to Rundle School to complete Grade 6 in the 2021-22 school year.
- Kindergarten to Grade 4 students from Redstone community attending Keeler School in the 2020-21 school year will remain to complete Grade 6.
- Keeler School will expand to Grade 6 for the Redstone community in 2022.

### Grade configurations for schools serving the Redstone community:

### Can my child stay at Rundle School?

Students who finish Grade 5 in June of 2021 will remain at Rundle for their Grade 6 year. If they have siblings in grades K-4, the sibling may remain at Rundle for the 2021-22 school year as well. All other students from the Redstone community must transfer to Keeler School at the end of June 2021. It is important to note that transportation services from the Redstone community to Rundle School will end June 30, 2022. After this date, there will be no yellow school bus service from Redstone to Rundle School.

### Will students need to register at the new school location for the 2021-22 school year?

There is no need to register. Redstone community students attending Rundle School in June of 2021 will automatically be designated to Keeler School in 2021-22, with the following exception:

- Current Grade 5 students from Redstone community will remain at Rundle School to complete Grade 6 in the 2021-22 school year. If there is a younger sibling and the family wishes the sibling to remain at Rundle as well, please contact the office at Rundle School.
- Grade 5 students from Redstone community attending Keeler School will be transferred to Rundle School to complete Grade 6 in the 2021-22 school year.

### How will students get to school?

Students are eligible for transportation to their designated school if they live beyond the walk zone. Busing registration begins each year in the spring, then routes will be developed and families will be informed over the summer of the pickup/drop off locations and time.
