## Notice Regarding School Designation for Kindergarten to Grade 6 Regular Program Students Residing in Cornerstone

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to inform parents/guardians and students who reside in the community of Cornerstone that due to continued and unanticipated enrolment growth at Grant MacEwan School, the school is over capacity and will be unable to accommodate all students who reside in the Cornerstone community for the 2022-23 school year and beyond.

Effective today, there will be an overflow school in place for all **new** kindergarten to Grade 6 regular program students residing in the community of Cornerstone.

### Cornerstone students who cannot be accommodated in Grant MacEwan School will be designated to O.S. Geiger School

Any new registrations for kindergarten to Grade 6 from the Cornerstone community will now be designated to O.S. Geiger School, which is in the community of Castleridge at 100 Castlebrook Dr NE; phone 403-777-6950.

Special consideration will be made to Cornerstone students with a sibling attending Grant MacEwan School and will be factored in when determining acceptance into the school.

Eligible students who cannot attend Grant MacEwan School will be placed on a waitlist and called back to the school once space becomes available. Students will only be placed on a waitlist if they attend their designated overflow school.

### No Changes for Current Students attending Grant MacEwan School

All students that are currently attending Grant MacEwan School will remain at the school for the 2022-23 school year and beyond, provided they do not move out of their community.

### How does a waitlist work?

If space becomes available in Grant MacEwan School throughout the school year, that space will be offered to students on the waitlist who are currently attending the overflow location.

### How will students get to school?

Students are eligible for transportation to their designated school if they live beyond the walk zone. This includes students attending the designated overflow school. Visit [Busing & Transportation](#) for more information.

Families can register for transportation to the overflow school. However, families should be aware that the ongoing driver shortage will impact transportation options in


the short term. This is expected to change over time until we can secure a permanent yellow school bus driver and route. More information on transportation registration and options will be provided to families by the school.
