Notice Regarding School Overflow Designation for Mount Royal School

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with information on capacity issues at Mount Royal School, and inform you of the accommodation plans. Mount Royal School is over capacity and is no longer able to accommodate all students who live in boundary for the 2022-23 school year and beyond. For this reason, the Calgary Board of Education (CBE) will be capping enrolment at Mount Royal School and designating overflow schools.

Effective immediately, the following changes will be implemented:

- A cap on Grade 7 to 9 enrolment at Mount Royal School.
 - All new Grade 7 to 9 students designated to attend Mount Royal School who cannot be accommodated at Mount Royal School will now be designated to one of two overflow schools: Vincent Massey School or A.E. Cross School. See the map on the last page for the boundary of new overflow designations.
 - A lottery will be held for Grade 7 students for next school year. Students who are unsuccessful in the lottery process will be designated to an overflow school and placed on a call-back list.

No Changes for Current Grade 7 to 9 students Attending Mount Royal School

Current Grade 7 to 9 students who live in the Mount Royal boundary and attend Mount Royal School will be able to remain at the school, provided they do not move out of the designated attendance area.

How do I register for school next year?

Students currently in Grade 6 that will be entering Grade 7 at Mount Royal School for the 2023-24 school year will automatically be included in the <u>lottery</u>.

New students in Grades 7 to 9 will need to register at Mount Royal School. To be included in the lottery, registrations must be received by noon on Tuesday, Feb. 14, 2023. Registrations received after the lottery date will be added to the appropriate priority level on the call-back list in the order received.

If unsuccessful in the lottery, students will automatically be registered at the overflow school.

How does a call-back list work?

If space becomes available in Mount Royal School throughout the school year, that space will be offered to students on the call-back list who are currently attending their designated overflow school. The call-back list is prioritized based on the draw order established through the lottery process.

How will students get to school?

Junior High School students are assigned to Calgary Transit as their mode of transportation. Routes can be accessed at www.calgarytransit.com through the "Plan a Trip" tool. While CBE works collaboratively with Calgary Transit, decisions on service levels are made by Calgary Transit based on available space and resources.
