Notice Regarding School Overflow Designation for Simon Fraser School

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to inform you that due to continued enrolment growth at Simon Fraser School, the school will not be able to accommodate all students from the currently designated communities for the 2023-24 school year and beyond. To address this challenge, enrolment at Simon Fraser School will be capped, and an overflow school will be designated for the Evanston community.

For the 2023-24 school year and beyond, the following changes will be implemented for students that live in the Evanston community:

- All **new** Grade 5 to 9 students designated to Simon Fraser School who cannot be accommodated at Simon Fraser School will be designated to William D. Pratt School.
- A lottery will be held for Grade 5 students. Students who are unsuccessful in the lottery process will be designated to William D. Pratt and placed on a call-back list.

No Changes for Current Grade 5 to 9 students at Simon Fraser School

Current Grade 5 to 9 students residing in Evanston attending Simon Fraser School will be able to remain at the school, provided they do not move out of the designated attendance area.

No Changes for Brentwood and Charleswood students at Simon Fraser School

Grade 7 to 9 students residing in the designated portion of the Charleswood and Brentwood communities, where Simon Fraser School is located, will continue to be solely designated to Simon Fraser School.

How do I register for school next year?

Students currently in Grade 4 from the Evanston community that will be entering Grade 5 at Simon Fraser School for the 2023-24 school year will automatically be included in the lottery.

New students from the Evanston community in Grades 6 to 9 will need to register for Simon Fraser School. To be included in the lottery, registrations must be received by **noon on Tuesday, Feb. 14, 2023**. Registrations received after the lottery date will be added to the appropriate priority level on the call-back list in the order received.

If unsuccessful in the lottery, students will automatically be registered at the overflow school, William D. Pratt School.

How does a call-back list work?

If space becomes available in Simon Fraser School throughout the school year, that space will be offered to students on the call-back list who are currently attending their designated overflow school. The call-back list is prioritized based on the draw order established through the lottery process.

How will students get to school?

Students are eligible for transportation to their designated school if they live beyond the walk zone. This includes students attending the designated overflow school. Families are required to register for transportation services by the deadline each year. Please note that transportation fees apply. Transportation service levels and fees are announced each spring for the following school year. Visit [Busing & Transportation](#) for more information.
