Modular classrooms and building a new school

The CBE would like to provide an update to parents at West Springs School regarding recent announcements from the Government of Alberta.

Modular Classrooms

Two modular classrooms were requested for West Springs School and delivery was expected for fall 2014. As of last week via an update from the province it has been determined that these modular classrooms will not be available before January 2015.

The 2 modular classrooms, once added to West Springs School, will provide an additional 50 student spaces.

New School for West Springs and Cougar Ridge

Recently the Government of Alberta announced the approval of a school to be built to serve the communities of West Springs and Cougar Ridge. Once completed this school will provide much needed instructional space to this west part of Calgary.

Until this school is built and ready for students, any new kindergarten to Grade 6 students who cannot be accommodated at West Springs School will be designated to Rosscarrock School.

West Springs School will follow the Lottery criterion that has been developed by CBE administration to determine acceptance into West Springs School kindergarten. <http://www.cbe.ab.ca/registration/registration/Pages/Lottery-Information-for-Parents.aspx> . Students living in West Springs who are designated to Rosscarrock School will be placed on a wait list and as space becomes available each fall students will be called back to West Springs School.

The CBE will continue to monitor enrolment at West Springs School.
