Administrative Regulation 1029.1 - Operation of Schools - Commercial Ventures

Section 27(2) of the School Act states:

"No person shall canvass, sell or offer to sell goods, services or merchandise to a teacher or a student in a school without the prior approval of the Board."

Principals may refuse entry of individuals, groups, or agency representatives to the schools for the purposes stated above.

- 1. Persons, groups, or agency representatives who wish to canvass, sell, or offer to sell goods, services, or merchandise in schools shall submit such requests to the Chief Superintendent for approval.
- 2. Approval will be granted only in very unusual circumstances and then a letter will be issued to the person seeking approval by the Chief Superintendent or delegate. Without such a letter, school personnel can be assured that no approval has been given.
- 3. Persons with goods or services to sell may decide to advise the schools by regular mail, which in no way implies an endorsement by the Chief Superintendent. Schools wishing to see a product and/or a demonstration may invite the representative to come to the school when it would not interfere with student activities.
