Grade 9 results are therefore misleading with participation reduced from 7,400 to <200 due to flood-related school closures.

In 2013 the May/June administration of the Provincial Achievement Tests (PATs) was impacted by the flooding in Calgary and Southern Alberta.

Grade 9 ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies and Grade 9 K&E ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies PATs were cancelled in the wake of the flood.

On September 30, 2012, CBE schools reported 7400 students enrolled in grade 9. Of these, approximately 7,200 did not write because of the cancellation of June PATs. For Grade 9 ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies, it is important to note the cohort size (number enrolled). The results reported here reflect the achievement of fewer than 200 of the 7400 students. Data for these tests reflect the achievement of a small number of students who do not constitute a representative sample of the larger cohort. Caution must be used in interpreting or inferring any trends.
