Background

- ❖ In October 2016, scenarios for Area V schools impacted by new school openings were presented to stakeholders for feedback. The junior high school scenario proposed for Woodlands and Woodbine students was for them both to attend John Ware School. The feedback received on this possibility expressed concern about possible overcrowding at John Ware School.
- ❖ To respond to the concerns raised, two new options were presented for feedback in January 2017. These options were discussed at an in-person session on Jan. 19 and an online survey provided another opportunity for people to share their thoughts and perspectives.
- ❖ This report summarizes the results of the online survey, active Jan. 20-28, 2017, which had 232 total responses.



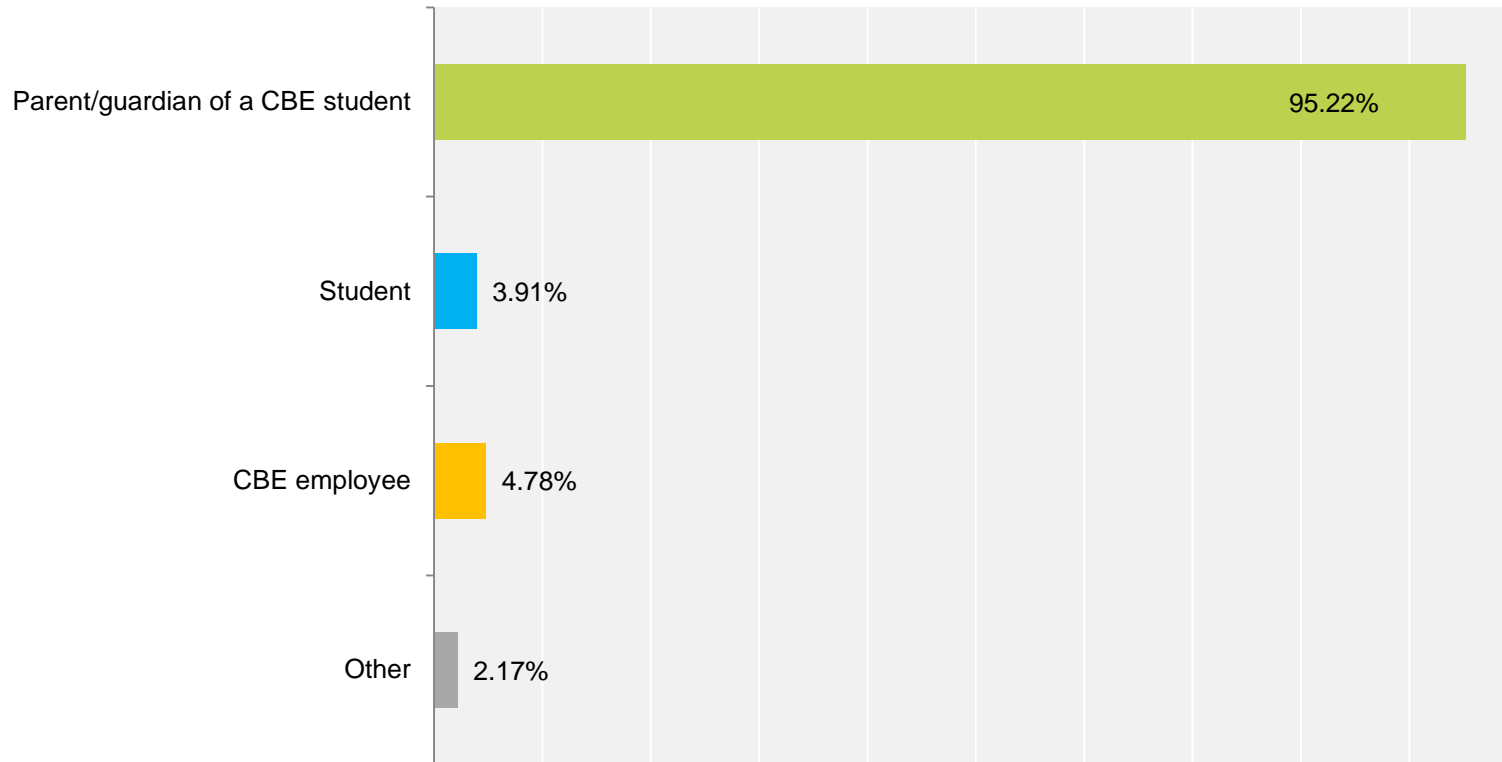

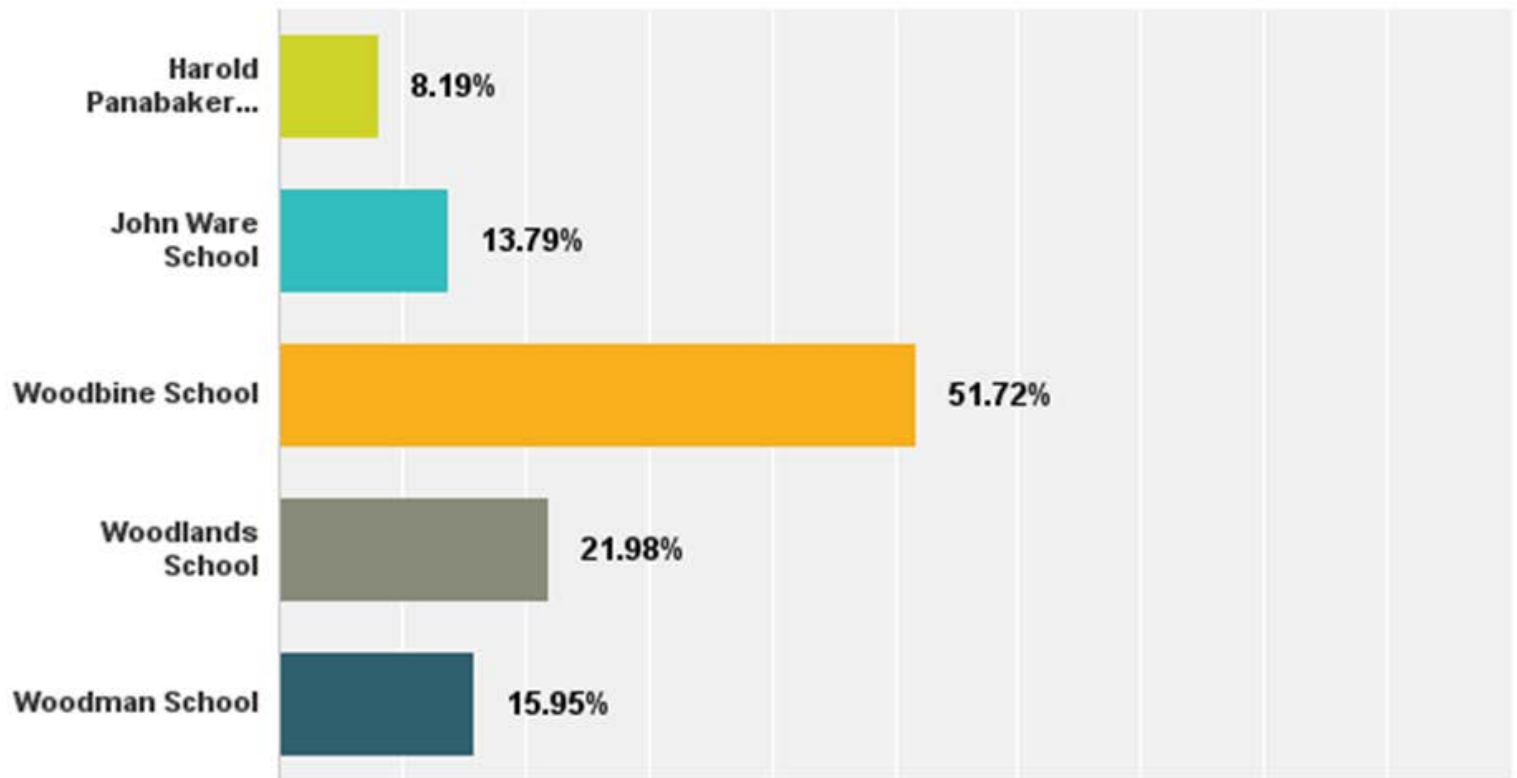

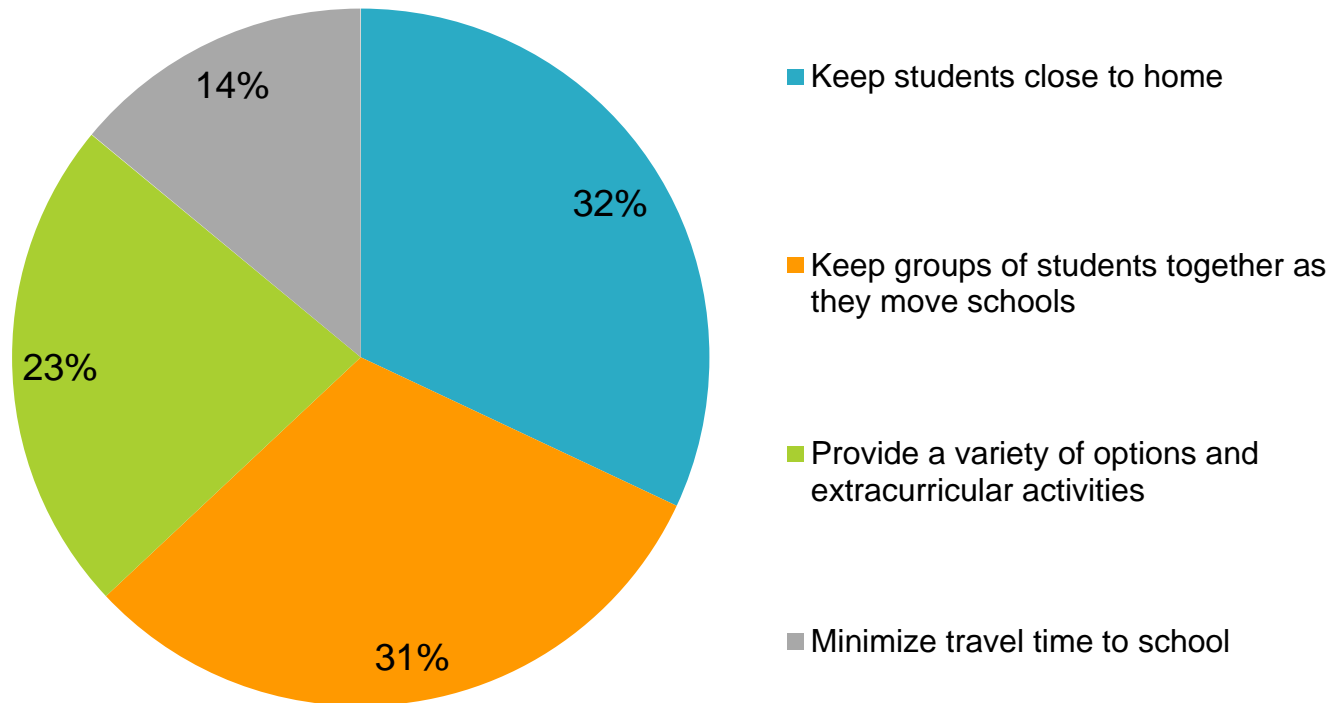

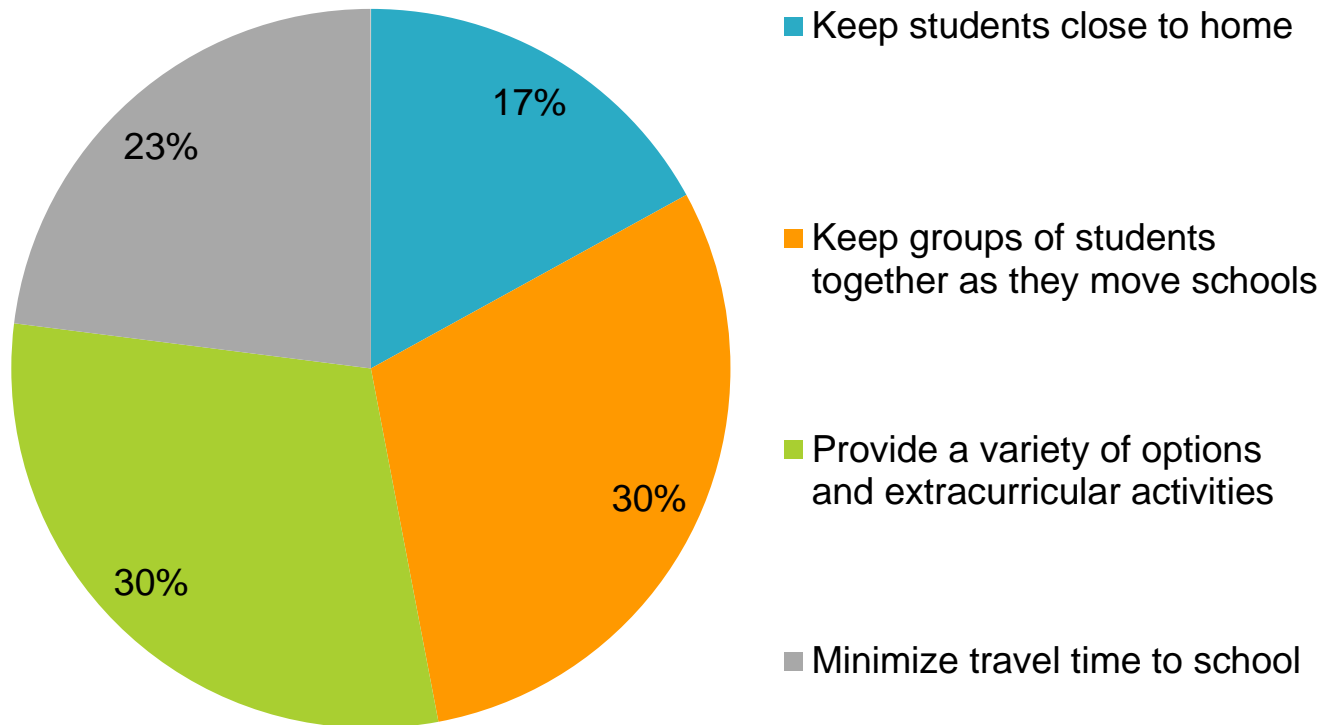

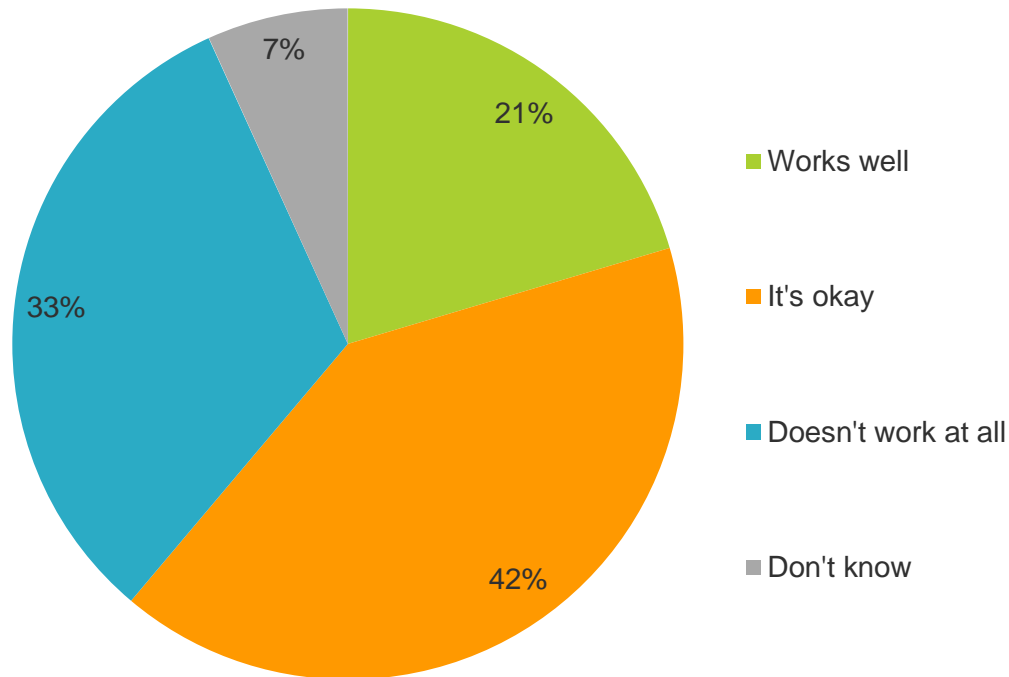

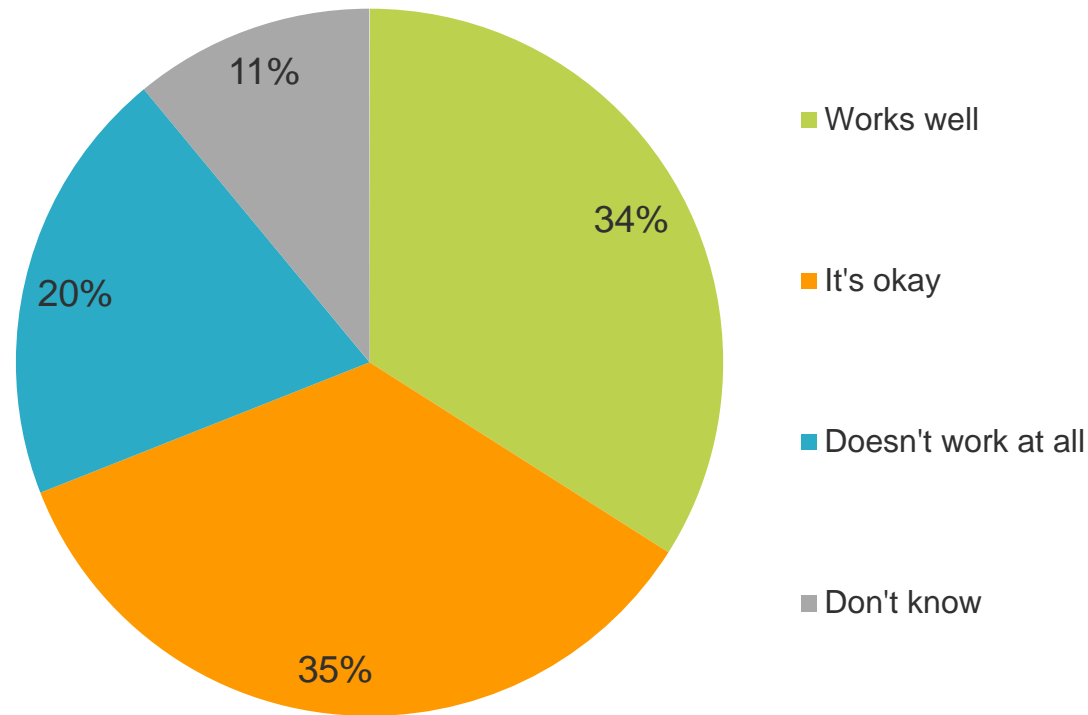

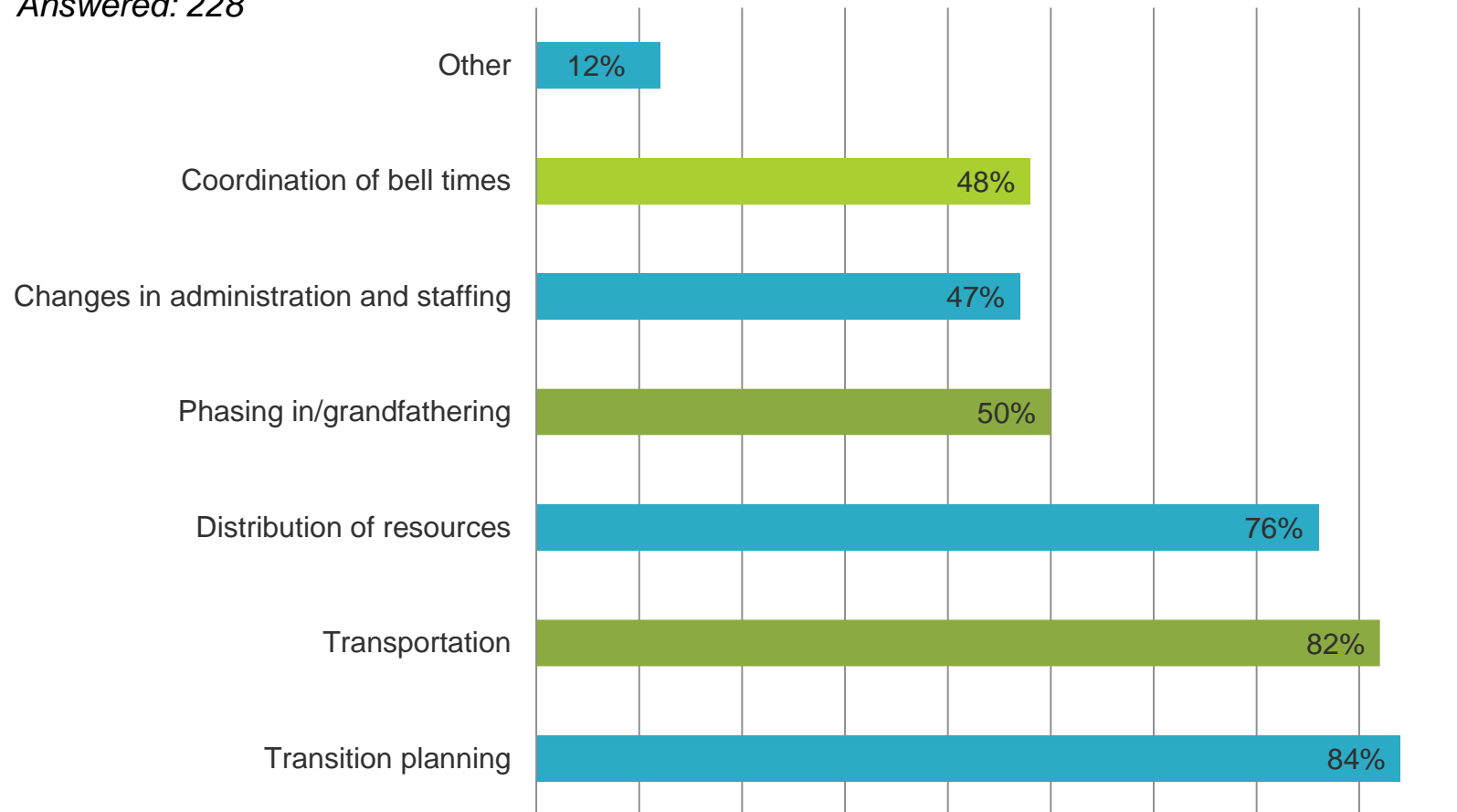
