

Dear parents/guardians,

Each year in January, Alberta Education sends an important survey to all parents and guardians of students in Grades 4, 7 and 10. In schools with fewer than 120 students, surveys are sent to parents/guardians of all students. The survey is called the Accountability Pillar Survey.

Your voice matters. It is very important that families complete the survey and return it to Alberta Education. The results are used to assess satisfaction with the quality of education in our schools, and the CBE uses the information to improve teaching and learning for your children.

Families will receive the English version of the survey through the mail, but Alberta Education also provides it in Arabic, Blackfoot, Chinese, Cree, French, Korean, Punjabi, Spanish, Tagalog and Urdu. If you would prefer to respond to the survey in one of these languages, just tell the principal of your child's school, and a copy will be mailed to you.

When filling out the survey, if you don't know the answer, simply proceed to the next question.

Alberta Education and the CBE thank you for filling out and returning the parent Accountability Pillar Survey. You can mail it back to Alberta Education free of charge, or simply return it to your child's school. If you have any questions, please contact the principal of your child's school.
