## Successful student demonstrates:

- A willingness to develop academic leadership and organizational skills in a setting that enables them to fully explore their passions
- A broad perspective on non-traditional career opportunities for females
- An understanding of the lived experience of women in local, national and global cultures
- An interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math (STEAM)
- An interest in learning highlighting how women contribute meaningfully to our society and lead change
- A willingness to learn through cross-curricular connections

## Characteristics of the program:

- Emphasizes girls' abilities to become independent and empowered leaders in school and in their greater community through curriculum outlined in the Alberta Program of studies
- Intentionally emphasizes cooperative and inquiry-based learning
- Explores opportunities to participate in STEAM across all areas of the curriculum
- Builds on girls' strengths to improve self-confidence, personal growth and understanding of the social construction of gender
- Provides opportunities for mentorship networks among members of the student body and with successful women
- Incorporates a focus on character in all aspects of the curriculum
- Students are expected to conform to the expectations of both the informal and formal school uniform
