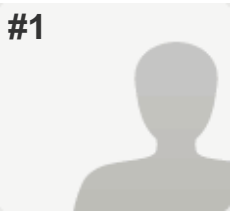

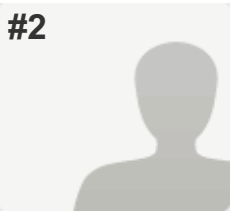

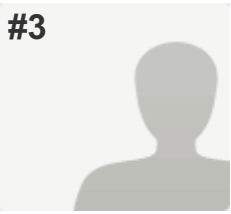
I think the walk zone is a reasonable area.

The distance from Aspen Ridge Ht to the proposed school is greater than the distance from My house on 14 Ave to the school. Now My question is why is My resident not considered to be within the walk zone but Aspen Ridge Ht is considered as being within the walk zone. The logic behind this walk zone mapping is not very clear.

The same scenario also plays out when you look at the distance from the school to Aspen Mount, Aspen Glen, Aspen Summit vs the school to My resident on 14 Ave.

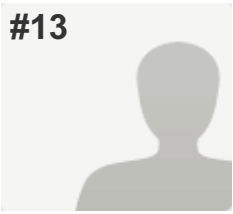
Q4: Is there anything else we need to consider regarding walk zones as we move forward?

If you take measurements with a ruler on an A3 print out of the proposed walk zone map, you will find that Aspen Ridge Ht is 17cm away from the school and My resident on 14 Ave is 13cm away from the school. Infact 14 Ave all the way to Webber Academy is 15cm from the school. I am trying to understand the logic behind considering a further location such as Aspen Ridge Ht a walk zone and not capturing a closer location as walk zone. I believe one of the main criteria for choosing a walk zone would be physical walking distance from the school.

Again if you take measurements on an A3 print out a step further, total walking distance on the major roads to the school from Aspen Ridge Ht is 26.2cm vs 19.2cm total walking distance on the major road from the end of 14 Ave to the school.

Having said all this I urge the committee to look at this again and reconsider the walk zone boundary to include 14 Ave beyond its current cut off point on the map.
