Update | Lakeshore School Contingency Plan

Re: School construction delay, 'school within a school' contingency plan details.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

In June, we communicated that due to construction delays, Lakeshore School would not be ready to welcome students on Sept. 1. We also provided a 'school within a school' contingency plan. Since the construction timeline has not significantly changed over the summer, the contingency plan is being put into place.

While we don't have an exact opening date, we do know the opening will be delayed by several weeks. You will be notified as soon as the school's opening date is confirmed. We are still working closely with Alberta Infrastructure and will continue to support the construction process to ensure the school is complete and opened as soon as possible.

How will the 'school within a school' contingency plan work?

The 'school within a school' model helps to make the eventual transition easier by keeping students together with their teachers and classmates in another school building. That way, the only thing that changes when the new school opens is the school location. This model allows students to build relationships and transition to the new school with fewer disruptions to learning.

Lakeshore School students will attend the following schools according to their Grade until the school's construction is complete:

School Name	Grades
Riverbend School	Grade 5
Sherwood School	Grade 6
Nickle School	Grade 7 to 9

Principals of Lakeshore School, Riverbend School, Sherwood School and Nickle School are working closely together to facilitate a smooth beginning to the 2022-23 school year and a successful transition to Lakeshore School.

In June, we also confirmed that transportation services are being provided to students living in the Lakeshore School designated area. Students have been automatically added to a route according to their 'school within a school' location, and no further action is required from parents/guardians.

Please note that transportation times will vary for each school due to Nickle School, Sherwood School and Riverbend School's varying bell times.

Nickle School:	8:05 am – 2:40 pm
Riverbend School:	8:00 am – 2:35 pm
Sherwood School:	8:10 am – 2:50 pm

Bus route, stop location and stop time information are available through [MyCBE](#) starting Aug. 17. The stop time provided is the time the bus leaves the stop. Please be at the stop five minutes before the scheduled departure time. Buses will not wait at or return to stops once they have left.

Do I need to register my child?

If your student is registered for Lakeshore School, there is no action required from you. CBE Administration will ensure eligible students are transferred to their designated schools outlined above while the contingency plan is in place and back to Lakeshore School once it opens.

When will I find out more information?

Principal Ian Fero will continue to work closely with principals from Riverbend School, Sherwood School and Nickle School on the school opening and transition plan. You will receive information on this plan with specific back-to-school information from Principal Fero by Aug. 26.

You will also receive additional back-to-school information by Aug. 30 from your child's teacher.
