What will the school hours be?

Will there be full day kindergarten?

No, there will be a morning and an afternoon kindergarten class. These classes will attend school on alternating Friday early dismissal days.

Will before and after school care be available?

A before and after school care program may be offered by a third-party operator in our school. The CBE Leasing Department is working with operators on arrangements for programs in several new schools. Although a before and after care program is expected for our school, it will **not** be operational on opening day. There are various requirements that the operator must meet in order to get the necessary licensing to start a program. It will not be possible for them to meet those requirements prior to the start of the school year. We will keep you informed as more information becomes available, but we don't expect to have information on registration or an opening date until the fall. Please make alternative child care arrangements for the opening of our new school.

Will there be a French program at all? Or another language?

No. Auburn Bay School will offer regular education programming.

Will it open on time?
