## New School Opening in Auburn Bay

Re: Changes to opening grade configurations at Auburn Bay School

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Calgary Board of Education would like to acknowledge your support in helping us reach decisions that positively impact all students. Through the expression of interest process we heard that different options work for different family situations and we are pleased to be able to offer two options. For September 2016, Grade 4 students living in Auburn Bay have the option to attend either Auburn Bay School or finish Grade 4 at Andrew Sibbald School.

The majority of responses received through the expression of interest indicated that families would like to send their students to Auburn Bay School for Grade 4 when it opens. For this reason, registrations of current Grade 3 students, who live in Auburn Bay and attend Andrew Sibbald School, will automatically be transferred to Auburn Bay School for Grade 4 next year. If you do not want your child to attend Grade 4 at Auburn Bay School, please contact Andrew Sibbald School by the end of April.

Transportation will be provided for Grade 4 students who choose to stay at Andrew Sibbald School for the 2016-2017 school year only. Applicable transportation fees will apply for all students taking transportation.
