Re: Next steps for the formal closure of Christine Meikle School of the purpose of relocation

As you are aware, the Calgary Board of Education is currently constructing a replacement school for the students at Christine Meikle School. Construction is moving forward and we anticipate it will be ready for occupancy sometime in late 2016 or early 2017.

We are pleased to inform you that the Minister has granted the CBE an exemption to the formal closure process. This will allow us to move forward with the relocation of your children to the new site in the coming months.

The exemption letter and report is on the agenda for the October 4 public Board of Trustee meeting.
